




## **Important Notes**



## Eligibility related to funds/budget:

- Nominee and Recipient of Funds must be northern.
- For the AIP and \$1 million categories, the total project cost cannot exceed 2x AIP funds requested.
  - This is not required for Youth Prize nominations.
- 20% Project Buy-in from partners is required for AIP and \$1 million category.
  - o Project Buy-in is encouraged but not required for Youth Prize nominations.




- \$1 MILLION PRIZE CATEGORY: One team can win \$1 million

For example, the in-kind contribution of someone's entire salary can only be counted if all of that individual's work is for the project. Otherwise, only the proportion of time that the individual will spend working on the project can be counted. Only contributions from non-team members count towards the 20% minimum.
